This is an expensive time of the year for many, so here's your last opportunity in 2011 for shopping in one place the WAIS way and saving some of your cold, hard cash.

Attention Stallholders! Judging by the stalls at our recent markets (averaging about 25) we're expecting another record turnout as members have the chance to both buy and sell ahead of the Christmas season. The Events Centre offers us the most attractive site in the Wairarapa for one of our markets. Lots of practical space inside and an equally wide expanse in front of the Centre gives us ample room for members to display their goods.

There is something of a problem, however, and that is that there will only be 14 (on-site) tables available for us to use. CARTERTON NOVEMBER MARKET

With the gale force winds only a few days earlier and further winds expected for the Saturday it was no small worry whether our traders could spread outside as usual on the day and when the morning came with grey skies looming overhead it wasn't the most promising sign to start the day off. But neither winds nor rain came forth.



Outside next-door to the hall on Merlenes' front lawn and the footpath were produce, treats, gifts, 2nd hand bargains, hot and cold food, coffee, and entertainment. Ljino twisted his morning away turning balloons into colourful artworks of animals, flowers, motorbikes and aeroplanes. Behind him, Eric kept the rhythm going teaching the art to trick sticks. In between the juggling, socializing and manning their stall, Hamish & Brodie had some creative time with the colourful play-dough Mum Karyn had made.



There were many about with the election on and the parade in Carterton, so it was a good time to show off our local currency goods to the general public as well as catch up with our WAIS folk. With a grand total of 31 stallholders goods represented, it's a good indication that our network is growing and that our traders enjoy the social aspect of gathering together as well as the shopping opportunities. With so many trader stalls all nooks and crannies in the hall were used to set up goods and it was a tight fit but manageable. Supermarket prices will be going up now, particularly in fruit & veges, so it's the best time of year to rely on your green directory and your WAIS market for your needs BEFORE you fill up trolleys at the grocery stores.



A SAUCY STORY

Ruth is known to most of us in WAIS as a regular stall holder with delectable jams, relishes, scones, craftworks and other produce. Here's testimony to just how good her culinary skills really are...

After our November Market in Carterton a pair of our traders set off home with their recyclable bags full of goodies from a happy shopping spree. Packing away items in the cake tin, fridge, pantry, bathroom, laundry and items for gift-giving, they were feeling richly rewarded. The first priority was to chill one of Ruths' bottles of grape juice concentrate and chill lemonade to have with it. When cold, the wife put the concentrate into two tall glasses, thinking at the time "this is a thicker brew than normal, will have to stir it". In went the lemonade, stirred and swallowed down half the glass.



He: "Are you sure that was the grape juice?"

She: "Yes, I put one in the fridge before I put the rest in the pantry". Another mouthful each.

She: "A different flavour to normal & thicker, still refreshing though"

He:" Is that the bottle"?

SHE: (after checking the fridge first) "Yes it is. See it's ooooh, um actually, we have been drinking plum sauce!"

And there was no sticky ending here. The next day while still chuckling about the mix up, a truck load of firewood was being delivered, much earlier than expected, with another load coming the following day too. Over the space of that 3 days our WAIS traders saved themselves more than \$320 in NZ\$, stocked up on household supplies, treats, gifts and had their next winters wood supply taken care of.

Examples like this are good to remember when the non-WAIS question the point to having green dollars when you can't pay power, phone, rent or tax with them. The money saved in your wallet from spending green dollars instead of spending cash for such house-hold items can certainly go a long way towards the house-holds various fixed expenses!
