For several months members using Xtra and Yahoo email addresses in our CES database have had difficulty receiving our newsletters, updates and other notifications. This is because the robots that manage the SPAM for Yahoo have decided that CES is sending you SPAM. It appears the last update and all recent enquiries and notifications (and probably this newsletter) are not being delivered. The IP address for CES is 65.98.61.169. Some members have chosen to change their CES email address and this is a good solution. Gmail, Orcon and many others offer free webmail services.
